Glynllifon – 10 October 2023

- Managers reported on the land-based, agriculture and forestry curriculum data.
- College Council members were given an opportunity to share relevant community information and a reminder was given of the upcoming Xmas food and crafts fair on the Glynllifon estate.
- Following the meeting a demonstration of the newly acquired autonomous agricultural vehicle was given within the old equestrian shed - this was the only one of its kind currently in the UK. It had been funded by the Welsh Government and was part of an ongoing project with Sheffield University.

Gerwyn Williams gave an update on the land based industries programme area, which included details of significant new equipment, learner attendance data, apprenticeships and student numbers. A report was received from the Farm Forestry and Innovation Manager, which included the latest news on the farm enterprise which was flourishing, a description was given of the different cattle and sheep stock, details of new staff, the Grasstec project for making better use of the pastures, latest innovation developments, including the automated tractor, an update on developments within the forest and the latest and upcoming events were listed. The college was asked to consider putting on sheep dog trials once again for 2024 - the Farm Manager would be giving the matter consideration. Members were given the opportunity to submit comments and ask questions.
