

College Transport to other Coleg Llandrillo Campuses – Rhyl and Abergele

If you are a full-time, further education student who:

- is under the age of 19 on 31 August 2024,
- lives in the county boroughs of Conwy or Denbighshire and
- lives over three miles from the College,

then you will be eligible for a free Arriva scholar bus pass to enable you to travel to and from college on public transport. If you live over 3 miles from any public transport route, then you may qualify for a connecting taxi to meet with the public bus. Please contact the Transport Co-ordinator to arrange this.

All students eligible for free transport will be issued with a termly Arriva scholar bus pass either prior to starting College or during the enrolment process when starting at College, these then will be re-issued to qualifying learners each term. Students are required to show their Arriva bus pass on all journeys.
